FRANKFORT — KENTUCKY STUDENTS WOULD BE FORBIDDEN FROM USING PERSONAL CELLPHONES DURING INSTRUCTION, EXCEPT DURING AN EMERGENCY OR IF TOLD TO DO SO BY A TEACHER "FOR AN INSTRUCTIONAL PURPOSE," UNDER A BILL INTRODUCED IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY STATE REPRESENTATIVE JOSH BRAY, A REPUBLICAN FROM MOUNT VERNON.

CURRENTLY CELLPHONE USE POLICIES WITHIN K-12 SCHOOLS ARE HANDLED BY DECISION-MAKING COUNCILS AT EACH SCHOOL. THE BILL WOULD REQUIRE EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ADOPT A POLICY THAT WOULD FORBID THEIR USAGE IN THE CLASSROOM WITH A FEW EXCEPTIONS. SPECIFICALLY, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT MUST DEVELOP A POLICY REGARDING THE POSSESSION AND USE OF A CELL PHONE BY A STUDENT WHILE ON SCHOOL PROPERTY OR WHILE ATTENDING A SCHOOL-SPONSORED OR SCHOOL- RELATED ACTIVITY ON OR OFF SCHOOL PROPERTY, UNDER THE LEGISLATION. A STUDENT WHO VIOLATES THE POLICY WOULD BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE UNDER THE BILL.
